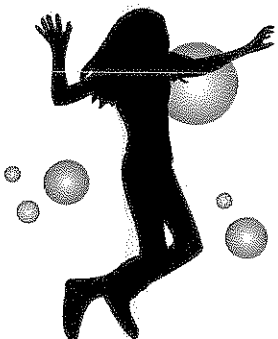
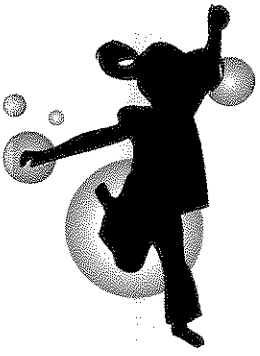

My child(ren) are under the age of eighteen and wish to participate in the Junior Jazzercise Program. I warrant that I have legal authority to sign a release from liability and negligence for my child(ren). In exchange for permission for my child(ren) to participate in the Junior Jazzercise Program, I hereby grant the following release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk and indemnity agreement and photo release.

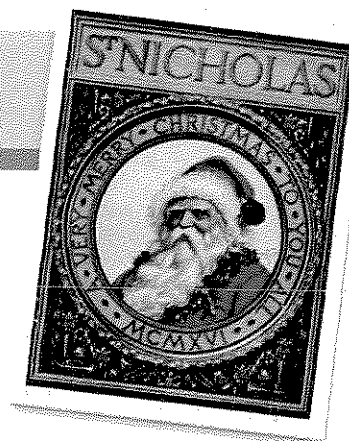
