One last thank you to the wonderful students and teachers for working so hard and walking so enthusiastically to help raise money for our fabulous Parish School! This year we will be putting the raised monies toward finishing up our wonderful Smart Room with carpeting. We would also like to continue to upkeep the advanced technology that we now have in place. In addition we would like to continue our quest to make the building as safe as possible with the possible purchase of another AED and adding more security doors. As of today only 47% of pledge forms have been turned in.
