
Dear St. Andrew Parish School Families,

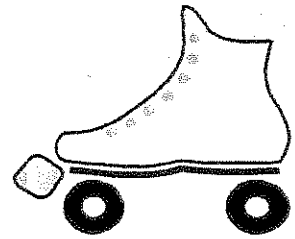

Dear Parents,

Beginning on February 6th through the 22nd, our physical education classes will be participating in an in-house roller-skating program. The skates will be delivered directly to the school and used inside our gymnasium. This equipment is specifically intended for indoor use and will not damage our floor.

This skating unit is being implemented because of its emphasis as a "Lifetime Activity". Skating provides a variety of benefits, which include balance, coordination, motor skills, and a top rated cardio-respiratory workout. During the program students will learn the basic roller-skating skills including, forward and backward skating, cornering, stopping and a variety of other skating games and activities.

The **FEE** for this unit will be **\$8.00** per student. The fee includes delivery and pick-up of the equipment, the use of the skates for 9 days for grades (K-4) and 6 days for grades (5-8). Also, included is rental of the **REQUIRED HELMET, WRIST GUARDS, ELBOW AND KNEE PADS.** You may bring your own helmet, wrist guards and kneepads. Please start bringing them to school immediately so we know how many helmets that need to be ordered.

This is a unit in the physical education class and students will be required to participate. There will be modifications made to help all students at their different skill levels. Safety will be the priority in this program and if you have concerns about your child please feel free to call me at school.

Please fill out the bottom half of the permission slip with the **FEE OF \$8.00** and your **childs shoe size**. Skates come in juvenile 10 to adult 15 and there are no half sizes. Skates come in boys size, so if you wear a 5 ½ for example, you may want a 5 for a girl and a 6 for a boy. Please make checks out to St. Andrews School and return by **January 27th**.
